Are You "Under the Law" or "Under Grace"?

Millions have been asked this question—never realizing that the question itself can be totally misleading. Did you know that millions who think they are "under grace" are actually "under the law"--and don't know it!

"For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God; Not of works, lest any man should boast..." (Eph. 2:8-9).

How many times have you seen or heard these words quoted? Perhaps dozens, or even hundreds! But are you sure you really understand these inspired words of the Apostle Paul?

First, what do WE believe? Perhaps some few have thought we believe in salvation by works. So, at least, it has been said of us.

But we don't. We believe, thoroughly, every letter of that scripture you just read.

lieve any individual can EVER be saved by keeping any law whether Ten Commandments, or any other law.

WHAT DO YOU BELIEVE?

But what about YOU? And how can you be sure? How can you come to really know the answer to this vitally important

question—one that has aroused almost endless controversy among professing Christians.

There is only one source to which you can go. There is only ONE way you can really be sure. That way is to check up—yourself—in your own Bible!

So right now, at the outset of this article, make up your mind to do just that. Perhaps you don't really bother to "check up" on most of what you read, but just this once—for your own satisfaction—check up!

The Apostle Paul urges, "Prove all things, hold fast that which is good." (I Thes. 5:21). What's more we do NOT be- "To the Law, and to the testimony," orders God through Isaiah, "if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light in them" (Isa. 8:20).

> Be sure you read each scripture you see quoted! That way you'll know your belief and your faith does not rest in men, but in the Holy Word of God.

JUST WHAT IS GRACE?

The place to begin is to understand the meaning of the terms with which we are speaking. What IS Grace?

This is a vitally important question. Important because your Bible plainly foretold there would be a great conspiracy to deliberately change the meaning of this simple word—make it become confusing to most people unclear. Today, there is endless argument among many religionists over the meaning of the term "grace."

What does it mean to you? Does it imply permission to sin? "Certainly not!" you might answer. Well, then—does it mean you do NOT have to keep God's Laws? "Of course!" many would immediately reply.

But wait a minute! What IS sin? "Sin is," the Bible answers, "the transgression of the Law" (I John 3:4). Well, then—if that's what sin is, if sin is the breaking of God's Laws, sin is, then, failing to KEEP God's Laws!

Well, then—if that IS true—and your Bible says it is—and if "grace" means you do NOT have to obey God's Law—then does not "grace" mean to many of you that you may sin?

"Of course not!" you might answer—but then—isn't it all a little confusing?

It certainly is! Satan and his ministers (II Cor. 11:13) have confused the meaning of grace in most men's minds. This whole world, according to your Bible, has been deceived (Rev. 12:9; 20:3).

Just what, then, is grace? Grace is, according to *Webster's New Collegiate Dictionary*, "Favor, kindness, mercy, etc.," and, the ecclesiastical usage, "divine mercy or forgiveness."

Yes—that's just it! Grace is FORGIVENESS! Grace is MER-CY. Grace is PARDON.

But forgiveness from what? Why, what is a Christian, but one who has through the shed blood of Jesus Christ, obtained mercy and pardon from his past sins? It is through the blood of Jesus Christ we must obtain grace! Christ died, then, to show grace toward us—didn't He?

"Of course," you would answer. Well, if this is true, and the Bible certainly says it is—then may we go on sinning after Christ has shown us grace?

Let's let the Bible answer not the ideas of men!

Paul was inspired to write, "What then? Shall we sin [that is, shall we break any one of God's Ten Commandments] because we

are not under the law, but under grace? God forbid" (Rom. 6:15). There is the Bible answer! Paul plainly reveals that we must not think we may sin, that we can ignore, or live contrary to God's Ten Commandments, just because God has shown us some of His great mercy.

Why did God have to show us His mercy? Why did we need "grace"?

God answers, "Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned" (Rom. 3:23.) we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His GRACE." (Eph. 1:7).

Grace, then, is God's loving willingness to forgive us of our past sins.

THE MODERN DECEPTION

Even before the close of the New Testament canon, Almighty God inspired Jude to write, "Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that you should earnestly contend

Yes—every human being has broken God's Holy Laws, the Ten Commandments. Remember, it is the breaking of these laws, as they are applied in principle, and as they are magnified by Christ in His teachings, that IS sin (I John 3:4).

Every human being has, because of his very nature of basic hostility toward God's laws (Rom. 8:7) been convicted of God's law as guilty of sin. The penalty of sin is death (Rom. 6:23). Christ died in order to erase our past sins. (Rom. 5:8).

THAT is what Grace is. It is the unlimited mercy of our God the unearned, unmerited pardon of our God, when we totally repent, of our past sins.

Notice it. "In whom (Christ)

for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints.

"For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ" (Jude 3, 4).

The actual history of what happened from that time to this time is now available. Remarkable, almost unbelievable discoveries are rapidly being made which shall amply prove that, true to the prophecies of your Bible, certain men DID creep in "unawares"—men who deliberately, with planned forethought, attempted to undermine the pure truth of God which was once de-

livered to the saints.

This, remember, was a prophecy of many centuries ago! Jude went on to describe these men as those who had a basic resentment and hostility toward all government, and the symbols of government, those in authority. "Likewise also these filthy dreamers defile the flesh, despise dominion, and speak evil of dignities." (Jude 8).

What is in the minds of most professing Christians concerning their relationship to God today?

Basically, it is simply this: they have become convinced

ing for God." It means living a "good" life, rather than an "evil" life. It means to think "good" thoughts rather than thinking "evil" thoughts. In a sort of vague, nebulous way, most professing Christians realize there must be a certain change in their lives when they "repent" or receive, or accept Christ.

To most—Grace is the state of a Christian who is "living for God." Grace has come to falsely mean, to MOST professing Christians, a condition of the individual, rather than a quality of God.

In other words, instead of

Let's clear the air. Let's not be confused. Let's come to understand!

WHAT REPENTANCE IS

"Repent ye therefore, and be converted" (Acts 3:19), said the Apostle Peter. To be converted means to be CHANGED!

This change of which the Bible speaks is far from a nebulous or vague sort of change. It is a very definitely described change, a complete and total change, a change that God requires in every facet of your individual lives. Jesus said, "Except you repent, ye shall all likewise perish" (Luke 13:3, 5).

To repent means to be deeply broken up and sorry over having sinned. Peter continued, as you read in Acts 3:19, "...and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord."

Surely every one of you know that Jesus Christ died for the express purpose of taking upon Himself our sins? Surely you all know, as a matter of basic, practical, Biblical FACT, that the sinner must call upon Almighty God to apply the sacrifice of Jesus Christ in order to forgive his sins.

David, experiencing the real depths of repentance, cried out, "Have mercy upon me, Oh God, according to thy loving kindness, according unto the multitude of thy tender mercies blot out my transgressions.

"Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin." (Ps. 51:1, 2.)

that a person should live a "righteous life." They have become convinced that they have been a "sinner"—which usually means a person who has lived an "unrighteous life." To most, an "unrighteous life" merely means having various "worldly" habits and interests, perhaps attending motion picture theatres, dancing, drinking, or playing cards. It may even involve the various modes and styles of apparel.

There are dozens of different categories in the minds of men as to what actually constitutes sin. But whether it involves various of these habits, indulgences, or "worldly acts"—most professing Christians would say that conversion, to them, means "liv-

understanding the true meaning of the word grace as revealed in your Bible, many of you have come to feel that grace is merely a Biblical term which vaguely means the Christian is in a "saved" condition. It means that God has smiled on the individual, "chosen" him, put him "under grace" and made him a "Christian."

How have YOU thought about it?

Have you ever really been clear on the subject? Have you ever been able to really track down, in your own Bible, your beliefs regarding your present state? Have you ever really proved, in your own Bible, the true meaning—that is, the Bible meaning—of sin?

David was calling for the mercy of God. He was pleading with God to extend Grace because of his past sins. Later, David said, "Oh how love I thy law. It is my meditation all the day" (Ps. 119:97).


When you repent—you repent of having sinned. And to repent from sin means not only to be totally broken up and sorry over having sinned—it means to come to a deep resolve and determination, with the help of God's Holy Spirit, not to sin again.

Never forget—what is sin? "Sin is the transgression of the law" (I John 3:4).

When you have totally repented and been forgiven, then God says "Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in the lust thereof. Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin, but yield yourself unto God . . . for sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under the law but under grace" (Rom. 6:12-14).

Do you see? A repentant person is a person who has been sorry that he has sinned. That means he is totally convicted of having broken God's law, is sorry that he has broken God's law, and has now determined, with God's help, never to break God's law again!

Paul goes on to answer a question which might immediately arise in the minds of some who do not know the meaning of the term "grace." He says, in the scripture immediately following the one you just read, "What then? Shall we SIN because we



are not under the law, but under grace? God forbid." (Rom. 6:15).

Can you now begin to see?
When your Bible speaks of being "under the law," it means, by its very context, under the "PENALTY OF" the law—not obedience to the law. To obey the law is to be "within the law." To sin—disobey—is to become "under the law."

How Sinners Are Justified.

Another very important clarification of terms is to come to understand the meaning of the word "justified."

Why is it that many of you have not really known the plain truth about such terms as "grace," "justification," "sanctification," "redemption," "conversion," "dedication," "confirmation," and other such "theological-sounding" terms?

Simply because there has been a great conspiracy to deliberately confuse these terms in the minds of people—keeping the precious truth of Almighty God about the most important subject

in your life—that of your personal salvation—obscured behind spiritual drunkenness!

To many people, justification means vaguely the same thing "grace" has meant to so many thousands of deceived persons. It means, to many deceived ones, a "condition" permanently attributed to a Christian.

Many people think once a person is "justified" he is "made right" from then on. But this is simply untrue.

Again, let's go to the only source to understand these all-important points.

"For not the hearers of the law are just before God, but the doers of the law SHALL be justified" (Rom. 2:13).

But how could this be? Simple. It is just as Almighty God says. It is only those who not only hear, but actually do and perform the laws of Almighty God, just as Jesus said they should in the Sermon on the Mount (Matt. 5:19) who shall be justified.

read is a very good example. Those who have now come to stand in awe and in fear of the holy laws of God, and do now realize they have been convicted of sins in the sight of those laws, have now become totally repentant of having broken those laws, shall be—as a result of their repentance—justified.

Justification is not a permanent "condition" of a Christian. It has to do with the removal and the forgiveness of past guilt.

JUSTIFIED BY LAW?

God plainly says that the works of the law, the works and deeds of the law—any law—whether the Ten Commandments or any other law, will NOT justify anyone! "Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law" (Rom. 3:28).

Of course! God did not say in Romans 2:13 that it is by the doing of the law that individuals can be justified. He merely said that those who are willing to do tion that is in Christ Jesus" (Rom. 3:24).

neither iustification But nor grace are a "condition" of a Christian which shall be perpetually attributed to him. The Apostle Paul, foreseeing this confusion and deliberate conspiracy to obliterate the plain truth of this simple doctrine, went on to say "whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in His blood, to declare His righteousness for the remission of sins that are past through the forbearance [grace] of God" (Rom. 3:25).

Could anything be plainer? Grace is not a permanent "condition" of a Christian, but is a quality of Almighty God, expressed toward a repentant sinner who now realizes his guilt before God's law, and now wants, with all his heart, soul and mind, to obey God's laws and principles.

Justification is not a permanent "condition" of a Christian, but is the immediate condition at the exact time of his total repentance and surrender to God; that is,

justification is the "condition" of the newly repentant sinner which is the result of God's grace.

Neither grace nor justification comes by the works of God's law. They do not come by obedience to God's law, or to any other law.

Rather, your Bible plainly shows, that God will extend His unmerited pardon, His grace to those who have been totally repentant because they have disobeyed. They have now resolved to begin obeying. Once they have made this resolve in their minds. God says such persons can BE justified. Once Almighty God ascertains that basic attitude of total surrender toward God, He will now extend His righteous and merciful grace toward that sinner, by forgiving him of all his past sins!

Now return to the scripture I quoted at the beginning of this article. "For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: not of works, lest any man should boast"

This is where most theologians always end the quotation. But let's read all of it. "For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus [the "new man" as a result of God's Holy Spirit] unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them." (Eph. 2:8-10.)

Of course! We are the handiwork of God, created as new creatures, once we have been converted, "in Christ Jesus" for the express purpose of living by every word of God. Living by every word of God means living in obedience to God's laws. It means living in humility. It means living a "good" life—but Almighty God is the One who tells us what a "good" life is!

He tells us by the perfect example of the life of Jesus Christ! Jesus Christ obeyed, PERFECT-LY, all His Father's commandments.

Peter says, "...because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow His steps, who did no sin, neither was guile found in His mouth" (I Pet. 2:21-22).

Did you notice it? Jesus Christ, by doing NO sin, DID obey all of God's Ten Commandments. He set you, and He set me, an example. Are you willing to follow His example?

God's Law Must Be OBEYED!

Now read these plain scriptures, and come to your own private decision as to what you shall do with them. Jesus said plainly, "...but if you will enter into life, KEEP THE

COMMANDMENTS." (Matt. 19:17). Paul wrote, "Wherefore the law is holy, and the commandments holy and just and good" (Rom. 7:12).

Paul went on to say, "For we know that the law is spiritual, but I am carnal, sold under sin...if then I do that which I would not, I consent unto the law, that it is good" (verses 14 and 16). "For I delight in the law of God after the inward

man" (verse 22). "I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God; but with the flesh of the law of sin" (verse 25). "If you fulfill the royal law according to the scripture, 'Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thy-

nant of God's true Church at the precise moment of their persecution in the wilderness, just immediately prior to the second coming of Christ!

self,' ye do well, but if ye have respect to persons ye commit sin, and are convicted of the law as transgressors. For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of ALL." (James 2:8-10).



The western world in recent decades has been inundated with Islamic immigration, whether claiming "refugee" status fleeing their oppressive homelands or by means of normal process, migrating for better opportunities. It is plain however with many of these "migrants" there is no interest in assimilation with the cultures of host populations. Rather the opposite. They demand that host populations tolerate Islamic culture, resist at the risk of being branded "islamophobic."

There are a number of aspects of Islamic culture obnoxious to many in the West. Apart from female genital mutilation and the endemic labeling of food items with "halal" accreditations, the wearing of the burqa by a section of Muslim women must be the most obvious affront. Seeing figures walking around shopping malls covered head to toe

in a black coverall garment is for many a confronting sight indeed. In Europe, the UK, USA, Canada and Australia it is becoming a more common sight, no less. As you will read further on, it is also on the rise in Muslim countries where a few years ago the burqa was fringe.

POLITICAL STUNT OR SOCIAL POINT?

On August 17, 2017 in the Australian Senate, Senator Pauline Hanson, Leader of the One Nation Party, entered the Senate wearing a burqa. She had prearranged with the Parliamentary attendants what she proposed to wear to the Senate and, her identity being known, was not impeded in entering the Senate chamber.

Senator Hanson later removed the coverall garment to ask the Attorney General, Senator Brandis, whether he and his

government would legislate to ban the wearing of the burqa in Australia. Brandis said "No." He then launched into Senator Hanson in these terms:

"I can tell you it has been the advice of each director-general of security with whom I have worked and each commissioner of the Australian Federal Police that it is vital for their intelligence and law enforcement work that they work cooperatively with the Muslim community," Senator Brandis said.

"And to ridicule that community, to drive it into a corner, to mock its religious garments is an appalling thing to do and I would ask you to reflect on what you've done," (this delivered with quavering voice and, it is reported, close to tears).

He went on to say, "I am not going to pretend to ignore the stunt that you have tried to pull today by arriving in the Chamber dressed in a *burqa* when we all know that you are not an adherent of the Islamic faith. I would caution and counsel you with respect to be very, very careful of the offense you may do to the religious sensibilities of other Australians."

For his tremulous trouble the Attorney General received a standing ovation from the Greens, and the socialist Labor Party Senators. No such standing ovation from his own side, the Liberal/National Party coalition government (so called conservative) side of the Senate.

Senator Hanson later said that her "stunt" was designed to start a conversation that would, she hoped, lead to the banning of wearing the *burqa* in public. She noted that before that conversation got going Brandis had stopped it.

In many countries—including dozens of Muslim majority countries—the wearing of the burqa and niqab (eyes shown) has been banned in public to various degrees and in only a few (eg Saudi Arabia) is the burqa (or niqab) a required item of attire. In the USA there is no ban, based upon First Amendment rights to freedom of religion and expression. Many Muslim women wear a hijab (a scarf over the hair) but many also wear no material head covering at all.

In Australia, judges and magistrates in courts struggle to get female defendant *burqa* wearers to remove the garment despite laws requirng such in some jurisdictions. But then, they also struggle to get Muslim defendants (male and female) and their "supporters" to stand in court when required—that is when the

judge enters or when spoken to. Invariably both objectionable behaviours, *burqa* wearing and the lack of respect shown by not standing, are claimed as "against my religion" and 'religious' duties.

Is the Burqa a Religious Garment?

Brandis, in his retort to Hanson, had admonished her for mocking Islam's "religious" garments. But is the *burqa*, an item of clothing that entirely disguises the wearer, in fact a religious garment? Is its wearing in public, or at all, a requirement of Islam? Must a female adherent of Islam wear it to be a "good muslim"?

For many, if not the vast majority of those born and raised in Western democracies, the appearance of the *burqa* in those western democratic nations in recent decades has been both confronting

and an affront. Indeed, to paraphrase Brandis, the appearance of the burga has caused offense cultural offense—to a large number of Australians (as well as Americans and Europeans).

In a number of situations covering or disguising a person's identity is recognized legally as just not culturally insensitive but a plain security risk. We don't allow motor bike riders to wear helmets or face coverings into banks, or other businesses, or courts (well, as noted above in Courts we still do). And we frown upon wearers of bike helmets and bandanas in public places without a good reason, such as riding a motorbike. But to complain of a burga wearer entering a bank, a restaurant, or even a court house completely unrecognizable, well, that's just "an offense to the religious sensibilities of other Australians," based upon the Brandis approach.

But is the *burga* (or *nigab*) a required religious garment?

DOES THE QURAN STIPULATE THE WEARING OF THE BURQA?

The simple answer to that question is, no. The Ouran instructs men and women to behave modestly in society (24:31). That's it. A couple of other references from the Quran

Muslim authorities today for the wearing of the burga comes from the collected traditions of life in the days of Muhammad. They do not come from any command contained in the Quran. The instruction to women is: cover your chest (24:31); lengthen your garments (33:59). There simply is no Quranic instruction to cover a woman head to toe.

WHAT DOES THE BURGA **ACTUALLY REPRESENT?**

There are women of Muslim background who seem to understand what the burga actually is, more so than many self serving western polititians. One such is Elham Manea, of Yemeni/Swiss nationality. Elham Manea is an Islamic scholar in the Department of Political Science at the University of Zurich, Switzerland, a former government commissioner and author of Women and Sharia Law.

Manea was in Australia recently and commented on the Pauline Hanson parliamentary burga "stunt". She said in an article published in the Sydney

Morning Herald, "The burga (nigab in Arabic) is a symbol. When you see it in a community, it indicates that an ideology and a radical form of Islam are spreading. In my field research on women and sharia law in Britian, South Africa and Middle eastern countries, I heard this sentence a lot: "Ten years ago, we only had a few women with the burga. Today there are plenty."

She went on to say, "Let's get something straight. The burga is not Islamic. It is a custom imported from Najd, a region in Saudi Arabia and the power base of its Salafi's fundamentalist form of Islam. Within Muslim countries it is very contested and considered fringe. Even conservative Mufti of Al Azhar—the highest religious authority in Sunni Islam—said in a 2010 TV program that the *burga* is a 'custom', not a 'religious requirement.'"

Manea went on to say that until 1979 the *burga* was not even mandatory in other regions of Saudi Arabia. She says it was the norm in Naid of course. But in other areas of Saudi Arabia pre-1979 the women worked with men in the field, danced together in their celebrations and did not cover their faces.

It is the year, 1979, that is significant. Manea notes that 1979 was the year of the Iranian revolution, the occupation of the Kabaa in Mecca by radical Salafis, and the Soviet invasion of Afghanistan. These three events Manea states led to an active Saudi policy, enforcing the dogmas of its politicized fundamentalism within its own borders and spreading it worldwide. Manea says, "Religion was a tool to fight communism and to claim leadership of the Islamic world. But it was not any religion that was promoted. It was a fringe fundamentalist interpretation of Islam."

Manea writes, "Women according to this world view are a source of evil that should be covered head to toe to protect men from seduction. They are perpetual minors, obedient to their male guardians. Husbands have the right to discipline their wives by beating." She further states that this fringe fundamentalism, that includes burga wearing, has a significant political dimension that wreaks havoc in any society in which it "metastasises". "It functions as a sect, demanding from its supporters to separate themselves from their wider society, which it brands apostate. Separation is not enough; one has to hate the 'unbelievers' in heart and behavior."

Manea concludes "So when you see women in a burqa, think of the ideology that is main-streaming it. We should confront it—Muslims and non-Muslims alike."

Finally, Manea notes that it helps to think of this issue of the *burqa* from the perspective of the tradition that produced it. She writes, "In Saudi Arabia, Afghanistan, and IS controlled areas women are forced to wear it. Why do you think women activists have launched this year a campaign with the hash tag 'the *niqab* (*burqa*) does not represent

me'? I am sure many of them are wondering why on earth some Australian politicians are defending 'Muslim women's right to wear the *burqa*.' Think of enslavement as synonymous to *burqa*, and their marvel will become clear."

It is troubling indeed that Australia's chief law officer, the Attorney General demonstrated by his rebuke of Senator Hanson's "stunt" of wearing a *burqa* into the parliamentary chamber, an astonishing ignorance of the place of the *burqa* in Islam. And to forgo the opportunity to affirm that the *burqa* has no place in public life or public places in Australia.

Does the Bible Mandate a Woman's "Covering"?

To close, what does the Bible have to say about a woman's covering? Certainly the Bible extols female modesty of dress and female virtue. But as to head coverings, the Apostle Paul had this

to say:

"Judge in yourselves: is it comely that a woman pray unto God uncovered?

"Doth not even nature itself teach you, that, if a man have long hair, it is a shame unto him?

"But if a woman have long hair, it is a glory to her: for her hair is given her for a covering.

"But if any man seem to be contentious, we have no such custom, neither the churches of God." 1 Corinthians 11:13-16.

Biblically, a woman's hair is her covering. She has no need of scarfs or other material coverings of her head in public to fulfill any "religious" duty. Properly understood, neither do the Muslim women who insist on appearing in public, completely anonymous, in their head to toe black garb. As Elham Manea concluded, "So when you see women in *burqa*, think of the ideology that is mainstreaming it. We should confront it—Muslims and non-Muslims alike."

"So ye in like manner, when ye shall see these things come to pass, know that it is nigh, even at the doors.

"Verily I say unto you, that this generation shall not pass, till all these things be done.

"Heaven and earth shall pass away: but my words shall not pass away.

"But of that day and that hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels which are in heaven, neither the Son, but the Father.

"Take ye heed, watch and pray: for ye know not when the time is

"For the Son of Man is as a man taking a far journey, who left his house, and gave authority to his servants, and to every man his work, and commanded the porter to watch.

"Watch ye therefore: for ye know not when the master of the house cometh, at even, or at midnight, or at the cockcrowing, or in the morning:

"Lest coming suddenly he find you sleeping.

"And what I say unto you I say unto all, Watch" (Mark 13:28-37).

This command cannot be ignored, nor can the many others our Lord has laid upon us. He commended the humble, the meek, those who show mercy and make peace. "And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts.

"If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.

"Let us not be desirous of vain glory, provoking one another, envying one another" (Galatians 5:19-26).

To live life by these precepts is not easy. Jesus Christ called the path that leads to life straight and narrow and said few would find it. The requirements of the righteous have never changed but today we are exposed to the perfidious vagaries of the world in a manner likely unimaginable by previous generations.


atop a missile.

EUROPE'S MIGRANT CRISIS:

Views from Central Europe

"We are not going to take part in the madness of the Brussels elite."

In addition, hundreds of migrants who have been relocated to Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania, which rank among the poorest EU countries, have since fled to Germany and other wealthier countries in the bloc.

The European Union has initiated legal action against the Czech Republic, Hungary and Poland for failing to comply with a controversial order to take in thousands of migrants from Africa, Asia and the Middle East.

The so-called infringement procedure, which authorizes the European Commission, the powerful executive arm of the European Union, to sue member states that are considered to be in breach of their obligations under EU law, could lead to massive financial penalties.

The dispute dates back to September 2015, when, at the height

of Europe's migration crisis, EU member states narrowly voted to relocate 120,000 "refugees" from Italy and Greece to other parts of the bloc. This number was in addition to a July, 2015 plan to redistribute 40,000 migrants from Italy and Greece.

Of the 160,000 migrants to be "shared," nine countries in Central and Eastern Europe were ordered to take in around 15,000 migrants. Although the Czech Republic, Hungary, Romania and Slovakia voted against the agreement, they were still required to comply.

Since then, several Central

European EU member states have vehemently refused to accept their assigned quotas of migrants. Poland, for example, has a quota of 6,182 migrants, not one of whom has been admitted. The Czech Republic has a quota of 2,691 migrants, of whom only 12 have been taken. Hungary has a quota of 1,294, none of whom have been admitted.

In the EU as a whole, so far only around 20,000 migrants have been relocated (6,896 from Italy and 13,973 from Greece), according to the EU's latest relocation and resettlement report, published on June 13, 2017. Of

the 28 EU member states, only Malta has taken in its full quota — 131 migrants.

Many so-called asylum seekers have refused to relocate to Central and Eastern Europe because the financial benefits there are not as generous as in France, Germany or Scandinavia. In addition, hundreds of migrants who have been relocated to Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania, which rank among the poorest countries in the EU, have since fled to Germany and other wealthier countries in the bloc.

Meanwhile, the enforcers of European "unity" have sought to shame the Central European holdouts into compliance by appealing to nebulous concepts such as European "values" and "solidarity." French President Emmanuel Macron, for example, recently warned:

"European countries that do not respect the rules should pay the full political consequences. There is a double betrayal. They decide to abandon EU principles, turn their back on Europe and have a cynical approach to the union which gives them money, without respecting its values."

Leaders in Central and Eastern Europe have held their ground. In Poland, Prime Minister Beata Szydło said her country would not be blackmailed by European Union officials. In a speech to Parliament on May 24, two days after the jihadist attack in Manchester, England, in which a Polish couple was killed, she said:

"We are not going to take part in the madness of the Brussels elite... Rise from your knees and from your lethargy or you will be crying over your children every day. to European Union quotas would "certainly be worse" than any punishment meted out by Brussels:

"We must not forget the terror attacks that have taken place in Western Europe, and how—in the bigger EU countries these are unfortunately now a fact of life."

"If you cannot see this—if you cannot see that terrorism currently has the potential to hurt every country in Europe, and you think that Poland should not defend itself—you are going hand in hand with those who point this weapon against Europe, against all of us.

"It needs to be said clearly and directly: This is an attack on Europe, on our culture, on our traditions. Do we want strong politicians who can see the danger and can fight against it efficiently?"

Polish Interior Minister Mariusz Błaszczak said that agreeing

"We must not forget the terror attacks that have taken place in Western Europe, and how—in the bigger EU countries—these are unfortunately now a fact of life. Remember, that the now very numerous Muslim communities in Western Europe started out as relatively small numbers...

"I tell my counterparts in Western Europe that the relocation strategy only intensifies illegal migration because traffickers get even more customers when would-be migrants hear that people delivered to Europe are being

given refuge in EU nations other than Italy and Greece."

Henryk Kowalczyk, a Polish member of parliament, said:

"Poland makes a contribution to the EU... We are doing what the bloc says, what the treaties say. If the French president was thinking of refugees, well that issue is not mentioned in the treaties and when we joined the European Union we were not taking on that commitment."

Poland's European Affairs Minister Konrad Szymański added:

"There is no conflict on values between the Commission and Poland—it is about how to interpret these values."

In the Czech Republic, Prime Minister Bohuslav Sobotka said that "given the deteriorating security situation in Europe and the non-functioning of the quota system, the Czech government will not participate in it." He added: "We are ready to defend our position in the EU and the relevant judicial institutions."

Czech Minister of Foreign Affairs Lubomír Zaorálek said that EU should focus on "economic and social convergence among EU countries, rather than attempts to distribute migrants with forced quotas." He pointed out that in some Eastern European countries, "the most vulnerable inhabitants are often poorer than the incoming migrants themselves."

Zaorálek added that "people

who are coming have no real interest in being integrated" and want to live with their "partners from similar cultural, ethnic, religious backgrounds." He said that people in Central and Eastern Europe do not want to "repeat the mistake of the Western countries" which have "neighborhoods full of thousands and thousands of people living in imperfect living conditions" and which are "very risky, not only during the night but also during the day." He pointed out that "there are no suicide bombers among Ukrainians or Vietnamese," two long-established communities in the Czech Republic.

In Slovakia, Prime Minister Robert Fico said that mass migration and forced multiculturalism would change the essence of his country:

"I think it is the duty of politicians to talk about these things very clearly and openly. I do not want to see a Muslim community in Slovakia. I do not want there

to be several tens of thousands of Muslims who gradually begin to promote their ideology. We do not want to change the traditions of this country, which are built on the Christian tradition. It has been like this for centuries. Sovereignty and national pride must be part of our ruling coalition."

Fico added that 95% of socalled refugees were actually economic migrants:

"We will not assist in this folly with arms opened wide with the notion that we will accept them all regardless of whether they are economic migrants or not. We must start telling the truth about migration."

In Hungary, Prime Minister Viktor Orbán has warned of the "explosive consequences" of a culture clash between Europe and migrants from the Muslim world:

"To understand what we must do, we need to grasp the true nature of the situation we are facing. Europe is not in the grip of a 'refugee problem' or a 'refugee situation,' but the European continent is threatened by an ever mounting wave of modern-era migration. Movement of people is taking place on an immense scale, and from a European perspective the number of potential future immigrants seems limitless."

With each passing day we see that hundreds of thousands have been turning up and clamoring at our borders, and there are millions more intending to set out for Europe, driven by economic motives...

"We must acknowledge that the European Union's misguided immigration policy is responsible for this situation. Irresponsibility is the mark of every European politician who holds out the promise of a better life to immigrants and encourages them to leave everything behind and risk their lives in setting out for Europe. If Europe does not return to the path of common sense, it will find itself laid low in a battle for its fate...

"Let us not forget that those arriving have been raised in another religion, and represent a radically different culture. Most of them

are not Christians, but Muslims. This is an important question, because Europe and European identity is rooted in Christianity. Is it not worrying in itself that European Christianity is now barely able to keep Europe Christian? If we lose sight of this, the idea of Europe could become a minority interest in its own continent."

Referring to Hungary's occupation by the Ottoman Empire from 1541 to 1699, Orbán said:

"I think we have a right to decide that we do not want a large number of Muslim people in our country. We do not like the consequences of having a large Muslim community that we see in other countries and I do not see any reason for anyone else to force us to create ways of living together in Hungary that we do not want to see. That is a historical experience for us."

How dare we retain our Declaration and Constitution which reference the Creator, His Divine



U.S. TOLD TO BRACE FOR "MESSY" CAMPUS UNREST

College president warns of 'ideological fascism' exploding across America

As colleges and universities prepare for the return of students in the coming weeks, one of the few administrators willing to criticize the tidal wave of intellectual intolerance on campus is expecting "a mess" when the new semester dawns.

Oklahoma Wesleyan University President Dr. Everett Piper gained tremendous notoriety in 2015 when he wrote an opinion column decrying universities for coddling student demands for safe spaces and the eradication of ideas that don't mesh with the orthodoxy of political correctness. In that column, he famously declared that a college is not a daycare.

He is now author of "Not A Day Care: The Devastating Consequences of Abandoning Truth." Piper said America needs to brace for more campus unrest.

"Oh, it's going to be a mess," Piper told WND and Radio America. "You will see protests. You will see riots. You will see the results of teaching victimization and vice for decades. When you teach victimization, you don't get anything but vengeance and violence

"The only thing that rescues us from this vicious cycle is to start teaching virtue. Virtue is

selfless. Victimization is selfish."

He fears many Americans still don't see how dangerous this campus intolerance and groupthink really is.

"What we see on the college green from Berkeley to Brown is going to consume our whole culture. What's taught today in the classroom will be practiced tomorrow in your courtrooms, in your living rooms and in your communities," Piper said.

"The proof of that is turn on the news, listen to your show, go Google the news and you see these angry, red faces of 21-yearolds who are demanding that any contrary idea, anything they don't like and makes them feel uncomfortable, be silenced.

"It's ideological fascism. It isn't academic freedom. We must confront this with the truth. Otherwise, we will not be a free society and a free culture," he said.

Piper rejects the idea of safe spaces at college, often referring to the quote from C.S. Lewis in "The Chronicles of Narnia" that the great lion, Aslan, is not safe but he is good. Piper said the same approach ought to be applied to today's culture.

"There's a huge difference between goodness and safety," Piper said. "I'd much rather have good education than safe education. Safe education will coddle you and comfort you. Good

Even outside of scripture, it's defined that way in our seminal documents, where we are told that we are endowed by our Creator with certain self-evident truths.

> "These truths that give us a free society, constitutional republic, are given by God. They aren't made up of power," Piper said.

And he said history proves that terrible things happen when opinions trump truth.

"Pol Pot and Mao (Zedong) and Robespierre and all the despots of history had opinions, and

it didn't end well. Christ told us, 'You shall know the truth and the truth shall set you free,'" he said.

Political correctness is just the beginning. The situation on college campuses is worse than you could ever imagine – and America's future is at stake. Don't miss the political blockbuster of 2017 – "No Campus For White Men" by Scott Greer.

Piper realizes his critics will reject his argument, but he said their logic only proves his point.

"If anybody disagrees with me and says, 'That's just your opinion of education. I think you're wrong,' the very claim that they're making – that I'm wrong and they're right – presupposes an objective standard ... that makes them right and me wrong. Therefore, they've agreed with me without even knowing it," he said

Piper also has a strong warning for parents who honor the truth as they search for the right college for their children.

"Stop sending your kids off to institutions that teach this pablum. Why would you do this?

"You're spending tens of thousands of dollars to send your kids off to an institution, that after you spend 18 years of your life

training up a child in the way he should go, in the first 18 minutes while you're driving off campus, they take pride in tearing his heart, mind and soul out. Why are you paying for that? Don't do it," Piper advised.

"Seventy percent of your sons and daughters will walk away logical fascism" is about to engulf American culture, he said he and others who love and pursue truth have no choice but to stand and fight back.

"I'm gonna wave the banner of the truth of Christ and of the truth of scripture," Piper said. "I'm going to wave the banner that scrip-

from their faith and their convictions before they're juniors. There's a reason for it. You're paying money to make it happen. Stop it," Piper said.

To avoid this frustration, Piper offered key questions to ask at any college visits.

"Ask the president, 'What's your view of truth and what's your view of scripture?' Then be quiet and listen. If truth is an objective reality, good answer. If scripture is a revelation of God and not just an interesting literature book constructed by man, good answer. If he doesn't say that, why are you spending your money?" Piper asked.

While Piper suspects "ideo-

ture is inerrant and revealed and that truth is an objective reality. If I win waving that banner, that's great. That's God's grace. If I lose waving that banner, frankly, I don't care. It's the right banner to wave. I'll go down fighting."

Piper has no illusions about how this struggle could damage U.S. culture, but he knows who wins in the end.

"I know the end of the story," he said. "I believe that truth will prevail. Between now and then, there may be discomfort. There may be dissonance. Iron may have to sharpen iron. God may have to redeem for good what others have intended for evil."

This pope has been tremendously destructive to all of Western Civilization. Obviously, he's concerned about the role Catholicism has played historically, rather than the kind of personal relationship Jesus exemplified as true Christianity. Pope John Paul II played a role politically in the encouragement of the people of Poland and other eastern European countries to rise up against the


those who've earned their way of life and redistributing wealth as it sees fit. He's cast that philosophy as "Christian," making it a Chris-

Who Really Changed The Sabbath to Sunday?

THE CHURCH FOUNDED BY JESUS KEPT THE SABBATH

The commentaries usually agree that the primitive church of the first century, in which the apostles lived, kept the Sabbath and Holy Days. It wasn't until much later that it was altered to the day of the sun god. When Saul wanted to find Christians to persecute in the first century where did he go to find them? He went to the synagogues, which met obviously on the Sabbath.

Acts 9:1–2, "Then Saul, still breathing threats and murder against the disciples of the Lord, went to the high priest

And asked letters from him to the synagogues of Damascus, so that if he found any who were of the Way, whether men or women, he might bring them bound to Jerusalem." (NKJV)

Like a predator looking for prey, Paul knew exactly where to find Christians. They were considered a sect within Judaism for years, in part, because they also obeyed God's Laws and kept the Sabbath.

Acts 11:26, "And when he had found him, he brought him to Antioch. So it was that for a whole year they assembled with the church and taught a great many people. And the disciples were first called Christians in Antioch."

It is beyond doubt that if the church had changed the Sabbath day to the day of the Sun God, the debate about allowing an exception to the circumcision law would have been ridiculous. The Sabbath was a much bigger issue than exception for adult gentiles regarding circumcision. Paul circumcising Timothy proves that he was not trying to cancel the law regarding Israelites. It instead shows how law abiding the church was in the days of the apostles. This of course, would include the Sabbath, or the New Testament would be filled with the debate as it is regarding circumcision. Nowhere in the Bible can any discussion about changing the Sabbath be found. Note that at the end of New Testament Church history, the Church is still considered a sect within Judaism.

Acts 28:22, "But we desire to hear from you what you think; for concerning this sect, we know that it is spoken against everywhere."

THE CHANGE CAME FIRST FROM WITHIN THE CHURCH ITSELF

Apostasy grew within the true Church of God. God allowed false ideas to exist in the Church to test the brethren. It was a method of seeing who would stand up for the truth. It also helped the truth

stand out.

1 Corinthians 11:18–19, "For first of all, when you come together as a church, I hear that there are divisions among you, and in part I believe it. For there must also be factions among you, that those who are approved may be recognized among you."

Jude 1:3, "Beloved, while I was very diligent to write to you concerning our common salvation, I found it necessary to write to you exhorting you to contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints."

The struggle for maintaining the pure doctrines began early in the New Testament times. Nearing the end of the Apostolic Age, many had branched away into apostasy over a number of doctrines. The second generation Christians are even more vulnerable to doctrines that are more acceptable to the outside world.

1 John, 2:19 "They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would have continued with us; but they went out that they might be made manifest, that none of them were of us."

During the Emperor Hadrian's reign, in the second century, many Christians in Rome adopted both the Sabbath and Sunday. Those that apostatized in our day went through the same process before accepting the world's day of worship, Sunday. The book, *The True History Of The True Church*, stated that the second generation was vulnerable to falling away. Over time the majority ended up following the false groups and the True Church is left small and scattered and somewhat underground.

If one were searching for signs of the True Church in the annals of history, the Sabbath and Holy Days would be major markers. The True Church of God (primitive church) of the first century was unrecognizable by the second and third centuries because of all the worldly changes. Montanism (strict asceticism), Gnosticism (knowledge, secret teaching), Arianism (Christ not co-eternal) and many other divisions arose at this time.

Many of the false doctrines came from within, but some came from without the church. False teachers infiltrated the church to push errors. One of the most law breaking and defiant would have been to change the Sabbath to the day of the sun god.

I John 2:22–23, "Who is a liar but he who denies that Jesus is the Christ? He is Antichrist who denies the Father and the Son.

Whoever denies the Son does not have the Father either; he who acknowledges the Son has the Father also."

Jude 1:4, "For certain men have crept in unnoticed, who long ago were marked out for this condemnation, ungodly men, who turn the grace of our God into lewdness and deny the only Lord God and our Lord Jesus Christ."

The Sabbath was altered by apostate churches that wanted to be more acceptable to the Roman Empire's population. These groups grew larger and eventually became the Roman Catholic (Universal) Church.

2 Timothy 4:2–4, "Preach the word! Be ready in season and out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all long suffering and teaching.

"For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears they will heap up for themselves teachers; And they will turn their ears away from the truth, and be turned aside to fables."

Paul predicted this attraction to the worldly pagan ways and the influence it would have on the Church of God. Some of the pressure was positive. Join us and be accepted, and some was fear based. The anti-Semitic pressure led some to want to change the Sabbath out of fear of looking too Jewish.

SUNDAY WORSHIP IS ACCEPTANCE OF CATHOLIC AUTHORITY

The Catholic church states that the Bible does NOT change the Sabbath! The only authority the Protestants have for Sunday worship is the Catholic

Church. They claim that those who try to argue that the change in Sabbath days is based on the Bible are dishonest. The Catholic Church based on their power made the change. Protestants are acknowledging the authority of the Catholic Church when they worship on Sunday, so say Catholic leaders.

Albert Smith, chancellor of the Archdiocese of Baltimore, replying for the Cardinal February 10, 1920, stated that, "If protestants would follow the Bible, they should worship God on the Sabbath Day, that is Saturday. In keeping Sunday they are following a law of the Catholic Church."

Daniel 7:25, "He shall speak pompous words against the Most High, shall persecute the saints of the Most High, and shall intend to change times and law. Then the saints shall be given into his hand for a time and times and half a time."

This is an end time prophesy, however some of the Law-defying work has already been done. The Sunday traditions are now so ingrained that it will be difficult to get people to even consider changing. Constantine as Emperor, co-opted Christianity to help strengthen his rule over the Empire.

The "Church" was given power. Over the years they used that power to force the smaller True

Church underground. Sort of like the Church of God in China; It has been underground for over a century. It is spiritually strong but small in numbers. Holding on to the truth would be a struggle, said Paul in his last visit to Asian Churches he founded.

Acts 20:28-31, "Therefore take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood.

"For I know this, that after my departure savage wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock.

"Also from among yourselves men will rise up, speaking perverse things, to draw away the disciples after themselves.

"Therefore watch, and remember that for three years I did not cease to warn everyone night and day with tears."

The true Sabbath, sign of the true Creator God, then and now, is the doctrine put in the most jeopardy by wolves and others who want their own following. Obviously the pressure for these changes comes from human nature itself and Satanic influences.

"Once Latin America's richest coutry, Venezuela can no longer feed its people, hobbled by the nationalization of farms as well as price and currency controls." Then the article begins by describing the one year old child who "has drawn the face of an old man and a cry that is little more than a whimper. His ribs show through his skin. He weighs just 11 pounds." It goes on to describe the efforts of his mother to feed him with scraps found pilfering through discarded garbage...

Then there is this, from the otherwise Fake News network CNN. But this is CNN's Money division, which apparently had a momentary diversion from every theme presented by the flagship's panels. Venezuela: political How a Rich Country Collapsed, reads the headline above the drophead, "Venezuela is running out of food. Hospitals are overcrowded with sick children while doctors don't have enough medicine or X-ray machines. Electricity isn't guaranteed."

It describes how Venezuela was a cash flush, oil rich, prosperous country that was plunged into

poverty and starvation thanks to the imposition of state control to make everything fair. "But inequality grew extreme. A small elite class controlled everything while the increasingly impoverished masses fumed."

"The country turned toward socialism in 1999 and elected Hugo Chavez president...But his government overspent on welfare programs, and it fixed prices for everything. It declared farmlands state property and then abandoned them, and instead made the nation dependent on selling its oil abroad." There you have it. The government seized pri-

vate property and internationally owned and operated factories and companies and then... And then the price of oil fell sharply, and monstrous debts had been acquired from the likes of Russia and China. The Chavez regime printed paper money like crazy, causing run-a-way inflation. "Prices could rise an astounding 2000% next year."

From *The Telegraph*, "Starving Venezuelans pour across the border to Colombia, as Caracas braces for more protests following deadly clashes." It tells of the humanitarian crisis which has engulfed Venezuela amid hyperinflation and critical shortages of food and medicine, with an accompanying photograph showing people streaming on foot into Columbia in hopes of finding food.

These are examples of but a fraction of the articles, largely from the mainstream press, detailing the abject misery, hunger and poverty that big government socialist policies implemented on the basis of "fairness and equality," have visited upon a nation that was abundant in food and international trade, until the government, in it's great wisdom, took control of everything.


